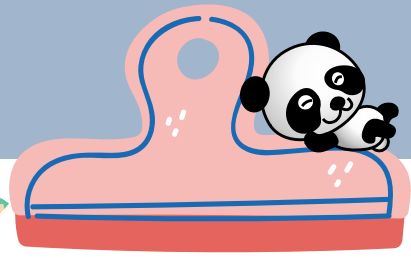

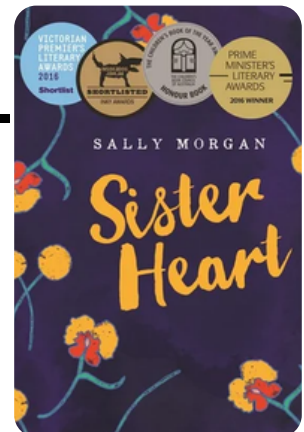


This is a book for 10 years and over. It's called Sister Heart and it is about a little Indigenous girl who gets taken away from her mum to a white people camp.

THE WINTER OLYMPIC TOUCH

The 2022 Winter Olympic touch was selected from over 100 entries in a world wide competition. Built from carbon-fibre martials and fuelled by hydrogen (of which is emission-free) this creation weighs 1.1kg, of which is about the weight of your toaster.

This design is full of patterns and symbolisation meant to represent a variety of different things. The spiralling construction is meant to represent the winding Great Wall of China, a fluttering ribbon or streamer, the skiing track and the many more things people see in this ingenious design. The use of red and silver (the main colours of the touch) symbolise the metaphors; ice and fire. This is meant to show that the touch can bring light and warmth into a world of ice and snow.

Did you know, that the touch rely started on the 18th of October 2021, and went until 4th February 2022?
