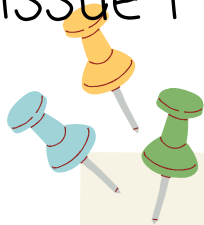

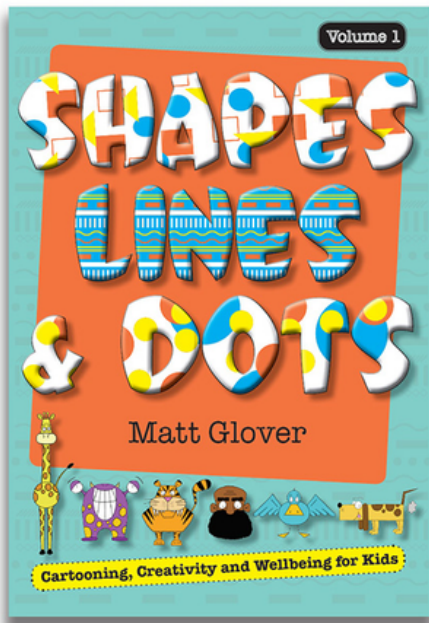


In the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics, there was 90 countries competing and 15 sports.

Abi Harrigan competed in freestyle skiing despite having broken her fibula. In 2022, there was the highest amount of females to compete in the Winter Olympics.

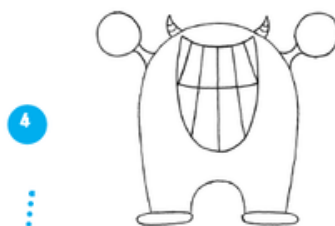
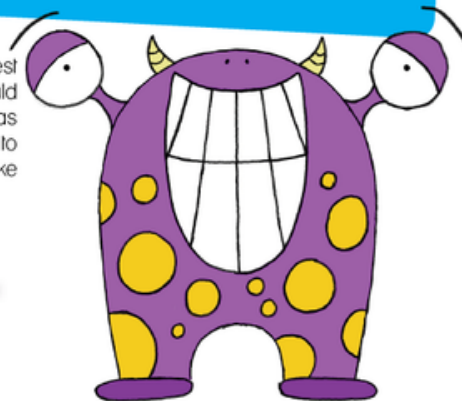
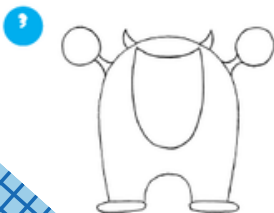
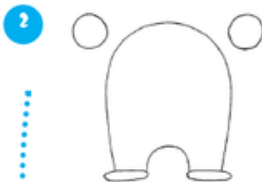




Matt Glover is a cartoonist and counsellor who believes that if you can draw a basic shape, line and dot you can draw a ant all the way until a farting dog.

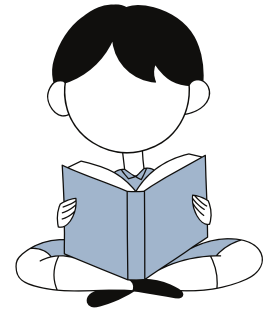

- There are 15 sports in the Winter Olympics
