



Step into PVS (SIP) Program

A great foundation transition program is about more than just the first day. It is how we ensure every student has the best start to primary school. Evidence shows a successful first year transition program can contribute to up to 60 per cent of student learning improvement in academic and social development.

Therefore, our school approach to Step into PVSPS Program is not only critical to a child's introduction to primary school but also their long-term academic results.

Our SIP Program begins by giving opportunity for our kinder children to be able to begin the program by becoming familiar with our school and their future teachers.
